Hot Vacation Ideas

During this cold time of the year many of us like to get away to warmer climates. A few suggestions of toasty places to go:

- 1. Close up all crawl space vents. This is very important to maintain crawl space temperatures above freezing, and to prevent water line freeze-ups.
- 2. Remove and store all outdoor lawn hoses. These must be disconnected from your outside faucets to prevent freezing and should already be done. Shut off all hose bibs in crawl.
- 3. Close 2nd floor registers part way and open 1st floor registers.
- 4. Remember to close windows in the locked position for best winter performance.
- 5. Check exterior door thresholds for adjustment. A screwdriver will raise thresholds tighter if you can see any daylight underneath door.
- 6. Clean furnace filter monthly.
- 7. Clean gutters out, clogged gutters may freeze up.
- 8. For freezing sidewalks, use calcium chloride NOT salt, to prevent damage to concrete.
- 9. Check all weather-stripping on all doors and windows.
- 10. Remove screens from windows.

Gardening & Lawncare Tips

Don't forget to store you plant bulbs for the winter. Put them in a bag and store in a cool dry place.

Save some of the ashes from your fireplace this winter for the gardening season. The ashes have nutrients that your plants will love. Sprinkle a moderate amount over soil around the base of the plants.

Cut down all dead grasses or plants

Store planters somewhere warm or they will crack.

Rake or mulch the leaves on your lawn to help fertilize it, leaving the leaves lay will cause damage to the lawn.

Safety Section

Kitchen

- 1. Turn the handles of pots & pans in towards the back of the stove so that your child can't grab them and pull hot food down on themselves.
- 2. Buy a stove guard so your child can't reach or touch the stove burners. Or look for a padded "apron" for ovens with a pull down handle.
- 3. Don't heat baby bottles in the microwave. The liquid heats unevenly, and while the part you test may be fine, another portion may be scalding.

Bathroom

1. Keep the toilet lid down or better yet, get a guard

that actually locks it. Children are often fascinated by the action of the swirling water.

Put non-skid appliqués on the bottom of the tub to prevent slips, or use a rubber mat.
